

# **The Real Facts About Sinfreeness**



## The Real Facts About Sinfreeness

1. The real problem on the earth is sin. This is the problem God has to deal with on this world. (Rom. 3:23; Isa. 1:18).
2. The Plan of Salvation as designed by God was intended to deal with the issue of sin. (Rom. 1:16, 17; Rom. 16:25, 26).
3. Sin can only be dealt with by God. No creation has the capability to deal with sin; because it is only one who has the ability to create could deal with sin. (2 Cor. 5:17; Col. 3:9, 10; Eph. 4:23, 24).
4. Only the divine provider of the universe was capable of dealing with sin. Jn. 1:1-4, 9-12; Col. 1:16-22.
5. Because sin in its quintessence is an attack against divinity, only divinity can handle sin. Ps. 51:4; Gen. 39:9.
6. Because of what sin means to God and His administration, only God who is the planner and cause of all righteous behaviour can deal with sin. Isa. 33:22; Isa. 45:21-25.



7. It is never expected for sinful man to have initiative in dealing with sin or to be able to correct sin. Rom. 4:1-8.
8. Sin can only be dealt with by making it cease to exist, or making it have no more existence in the person. Eze. 11:19, 20; Zech. 3:3, 4.
9. Thus God deals with sin in man. It is God that is supposed to correct the problem of sin in man. Rom. 6:17, 18, 22, 23.

10. Sinful human beings do not stop sinning in their existence, it is God that deals with sin in the sinner. Rom. 3:23; Rom. 3:29, 30.
11. God is the sole source and initiator of handling sin in the sinner, He NEVER asks us to do so. Rom. 5:6-9.
12. It is God only that forgives sin, thus it is only God that can handle sin. Mk. 2:5-7; Ps. 32:5.
13. God takes away sin from the penitent sinner; this is what His Plan does. (Rom. 1:16, 17; 1 Jn. 3:5).
14. His Plan does not facilitate for continuing existence of sin in the sinner, nor does it in any form ignores sin in him. God's action is always to rid the sinner completely of his sin. (2 Cor. 5:17, 18; 1 Jn. 3:8).
15. Neither does God cause some sins to cease in the man, and some to remain or continue. No! When God deals with sin in the man, He cleanses him from all sins. 1 Jn. 1:7, 9.

### **GOD'S CLEANSING ACTION**

#### **FROM ALL SINS**

16. With just one sin alive as sinning in the man, he is still in sin, but God takes away all sins if He is to make the man free from sin. Jn. 8:34, 32, 36.

### **FREEDOM FROM SIN**

#### **ALL SINS TAKEN AWAY**

17. In God's Plan, sins must be exchanged for no sins or sinning no more. Nothing else but this fact is what God is interested in. Zech. 3:3-5; Jn. 5:14; Jn. 8:11.

### **EXCHANGED**

#### **SINNING FOR NO SINNING**

18. Thus God's salvation to sinful man is to take his sins away from him. (1 Jn. 3:5; Matt. 1:21).

19. In a summary; the intent of God is to make man sinfree or free from the existence of sin in him. (Jn. 3:17; Matt. 1:21; 1 Jn. 3:5).
20. Justification is the means that God has instituted to make man sinfree. It is a wonderful science that reveals how God makes a sinner sinfree. Rom. 6:6, 7, 17, 18.

## **JUSTIFICATION**

### **GOD MAKES THE SINNER SINFREE**

21. Sinfree is not a gradual separation from sinning over a period of time, for if only one sin remains in the man, he is not the least free from sin. 1 Jn. 3:7-10.
22. Sinfreeness is a switch from sinfulness. Before the person was made sinfree, he was sinful, then, with God's divine miracle, He changes the man from sinfulness to sinfreeness; it is indeed a switch and not a gradual change over a period of time. (1 Cor. 6:9-11; Tit. 3:5-7). Zech. 3:3-5.

## **THE SWITCH**

### **FROM SINFULNESS TO SINFREENESS**

23. The idea of the new birth in God's Plan is making the person sinfree immediately, not leaving some sins yet functioning in the man while freeing him from some. It is making the man switch from sinning to sinfreeness. 1 Jn. 3:9.

## **NEW BIRTH**

### **SWITCH FROM**

### **SINNING TO SINFREENESS**


24. God is the sole One that removes sin from man making him sinfree; it was never a work that was done by man over a lifetime. (Heb. 8:10-12; Ps. 37:30, 31).
25. When God makes a man sinfree, it is necessary for the man to esteem himself so as God has made him, for there shall be no progress in the next step and in the sanctification that can only follow sinfreeness. Rom. 6:1, 2, 11-13.

## **SELF-ESTEEM OF SINFREENESS**


### **FOR SANCTIFICATION**

26. Sinfreeness is to be maintained in God's Plan by the following facts:
  - a. It must be maintained by abiding in Christ. 1 Jn. 3:6; 1 Jn. 2:6.

- b. It must be maintained by sanctification, which is gradual growth in sinfreeness itself. (Jn. 17:17; 1 Jn. 2:5; 1 Pet. 3:18; 1 Jn. 5:18).
- c. It is by obedience to the Word of God that the man maintains sinfreeness. Ps. 119:9, 11.



27. Another reality that is very biblical with regards to sinfreeness is the following:
- a. God wants man to have this sinfreeness at all times without any break in its duration or time flow. (Ps. 106:3; Ps. 119:44).
  - b. But since the experience of most Christians that are true is Punctuated Sinfreeness, that is, sinfreeness at some times, then sinfreeness again, at which the person is made sinfree again, God has a plan to deal with that. (Jam. 5:19, 20; 1 Jn. 2:1).



28. But it is presented as a shame if one does not have a knowledge of God that causes sinfreeness. It is a shame if one does not know the switch that takes place. 1 Cor. 15:34.

29. We should absolutely know that a sinfree man does not live in sin anymore. This is a Bible teaching. Rom. 6:1, 2.
30. Finally, the real mystery of sin and of holiness is that God wants man to be righteous exactly as He is righteous (sinfree), no less. 1 Jn. 3:7, 3.
